Intermediate Workshop on Ketamine-Assisted Psychotherapy: Clinical Issues Part 2 Live/Online

Course Description

In this workshop, we focus on several key clinical issues and relevant themes in this treatment protocol, including: Attachment issues in KAP, work with countertransference in KAP, collaboration with outside providers of ketamine patients, implementation of virtual KAP, implementation of group KAP, and integration of spiritual experiences.
